# VIBURNUMS

Have you ever felt that your garden interest dwindles in the fall? Well, there's no need to have that happen when you can select plants that have berries for fall and winter interest. Viburnums are a wonderful option.

The selection to choose from is enormous, with a wide range of size, shape and form.

Most viburnums

tend to bloom during the spring with white or pink blossoms.
Some flowers are even fragrant, like carelessii, judii or 'Mohawk'. Flower shapes are either lacecap or mophead, similar to hydrangeas. 'Summer Snowflake' is rather upright in habit, with white lacecaps that bloom throughout the entire summer.

As flowers fade, fruit develops which can vary in color from yellow to orange, red, blue or black (depending on the variety), attracting birds and other wildlife. Ideally you should prune right after flowering to ensure blooms for the following year.


Viburnum foliage can be rounded, lance-shaped or

toothed; smooth, velvety or rough. Many of the deciduous varieties have outstanding fall leaf color.

Viburnums are great grown in the shrub border or as an understorey plant for woodland gardens. They do well in

any moderately loamy, well-drained soil in full sun or partial shade. They also have great insect resistance and are low maintenance.
